

# Vulpix

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## Materials

Worsted Weight Yarn  
I love this yarn – Toasted Almond  
I love this yarn – Burnt Pumpkin  
I love this yarn – Ivory  
I love this yarn – Brown  
Size E crochet hook  
Polyfiberfill  
Large Eye Needle

## Abbreviations

SC – Single Crochet  
HDC – Half Double Crochet  
CH- Chain  
FO – Fasten Off  
SL ST – Slip Stitch  
INC – Make two Single Crochet in Same  
Stitch  
DEC – Single Crochet two stitches  
together  
BLO – Back Loops Only  
FLO – Front Loops Only

*Note: Almost the entire project is worked  
in the round. Use a stitch marker or a*

*scrap piece of yarn to mark the  
beginning of each row. Then you don't  
have to count every row. Do not join  
unless instructed to.*

*Parentheses indicate a repeat. Repeat  
the stitches in the parentheses for the  
number of times indicated.*

*The bracketed number [ ] is the number  
of stitches at the end of each row.*

*I spread my increases out so there isn't a  
seam on the finished piece. If you do not  
like this method, you can do regular  
increases.*

## HEAD

In Toasted Almond

CH 2

**Round 1:** 6 SC in 2<sup>nd</sup> CH from hook [6].

**Round 2:** 2 SC, 4 INC [10].

**Round 3:** 2 SC (SC, INC) 4 times [14].

**Round 4-5:** 2 rows SC [14 stitches in  
each row].

**Round 6:** 4 INC, 10 SC [18].

**Round 7:** (SC, INC, SC) 6 times [24].

**Round 8:** (3 SC, INC) 6 times [30].

**Round 9:** (INC, 2 SC) 4 times, INC, 8 SC, INC, 8 SC [36].

**Round 10:** (5 SC, INC) 6 times [42].

**Round 11:** (3 SC, INC, 3 SC) 6 times [48].

**Rounds 12 – 19:** SC in each stitch for 8 rows [48 stitches per row].

**Round 20:** (DEC, 6 SC) 6 times [42].

**Round 21:** (DEC, 5 SC) 6 times [36].

**Round 22:** (DEC, 4 SC) 6 times [30].

Start stuffing here. Stuff firmly.

**Round 23:** (DEC, 3 SC) 6 times [24]

**Round 24:** (DEC, 2 SC) 6 times [18]

**Round 25:** (DEC, 1 SC) 6 times [12]

**Round 26:** (DEC) 6 times [6]

FO leaving a long tail. Thread tail through last 6 stitches and pull up tight to close hole.

Embroider nose in Brown

## **BODY**

In Toasted Almond

Ch 2

**Round 1:** 8 SC in 2<sup>nd</sup> CH from hook [8].

**Round 2:** (INC) 8 times [16].

**Round 3:** (SC, INC) 8 times [24].

**Round 4:** (SC, INC, SC) 8 times [32].

**Round 5:** (3 SC, INC) 8 times [40].

**Rounds 6-25:** 20 rows SC [40 stitches per row].

Start stuffing here. Stuff firmly

**Round 26:** (3 SC, DEC) 8 times [32].

**Round 27:** (2 SC, DEC) 8 times [24].

**Round 28:** (SC, DEC) 8 times [16].

FO leaving a long tail. Thread tail through last 8 stitches and pull up tight to close hole.

## **LEGS (Make 4)**

In Brown

Ch 2

**Round 1:** 6 SC in 2<sup>nd</sup> CH from hook [6].

**Round 2:** (INC) 6 times [12].

**Round 3:** (SC, INC) 6 times [18].

**Round 4:** SC in BLOs [18].

**Round 5:** SC row [18].

**Round 6:** DEC 4 times, 10 SC [14].

**Rounds 7-8:** 2 rows SC [14 stitches per row] Change colors to Toasted Almond in last stitch.

**Rounds 9-13:** 5 rows SC [14 stitches per row].

Fasten off. Don't sew legs on until after you sew on the belly patch.

## **EARS (make 2)**

To make the ears, you will use both Brown and Toasted Almond changing colors halfway each round.

In Toasted Almond

Ch 2

**Round 1:** 3 SC in 2<sup>nd</sup> Ch from hook, change colors, 3 SC in Brown, change back to Toasted Almond [6].

**Round 2:** INC, 2 SC change colors to Brown INC, 2SC change colors back [8].

**Round 3:** INC, 3 SC change colors to Brown INC, 3 SC change colors back [10].

**Round 4:** INC, 4 SC change colors to Brown INC, 4 SC change colors back [12].

**Round 5:** INC, 5 SC change colors to Brown INC, 5 SC change colors back [14].

**Round 6:** INC, 6 SC change colors to Brown INC, 6 SC change colors back [16].

**Round 7:** INC, 7 SC change colors to Brown INC, 7 SC change colors back [18].

**Rounds 8-9:** 2 rows SC as follows (9 SC in each color) [18 stitches per row]

**Round 10.** In Brown only SC the bottom closed. Place a spike stitch in the center. (to spike stitch get insert hook 2 stitches above current stitch and pull up your yarn.)

## EYES (make 2)

In Brown, Ch 5

**Round 1:** SC in 2<sup>nd</sup> Ch from hook, 2 SC, 3 SC in last stitch, continuing using the unused loops on the other side 3 SC, 3 SC in last stitch [12].

**Round 2:** (3 SC, 3 INC) 2 times [18].  
Fasten off. Highlight each eye in ivory.  
Using lt taupe embroider a circle in on the side of the eye. Sew to head.

## BANGS (Make 3) – in Burnt Pumpkin

Ch 2

**Round 1:** 6 SC in 2<sup>nd</sup> Ch from hook [6].

**Round 2:** INC in each stitch [12].

**Rounds 3-5:** 3 rows SC [12 stitches per row].

**Round 6:** SC opening closed [6].  
Fasten off and sew to forehead.



## HAIR (Make 3) – in Burnt Pumpkin

Ch 2

**Round 1:** 4 SC in 2<sup>nd</sup> Ch from hook [4].

**Round 2:** INC in each stitch [8].

**Rounds 3-17:** 15 rows SC [8 stitches per row].

**Round 18:** SC opening closed [4].  
Fasten Off. Roll the hair into a curl and sew behind bangs.

## BELLY PATCH – in Ivory

*Belly patch is worked back and forth not in the round.*

Ch 11

**Row 1:** SC in 2<sup>nd</sup> Ch from hook and remaining 9 stitches, Ch 1 Turn [10].

**Rows 2-14:** SC for 13 rows [10 stitches per row].

**Row 15:** DEC, 6 SC, DEC [8].

**Rows 16-34:** 19 rows SC [8 stitches per row].

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing to attach to body.

## TAIL (make 5) – in Burnt Pumpkin

Ch 2

**Round 1:** 6 SC in 2<sup>nd</sup> Ch from hook [6].

**Round 2:** INC in each stitch [12].

**Rounds 3-16:** 14 rows SC [12 stitches per row]

The next portion works in the curls at the ends of the tails. When it says SC to row or curl, you will use the stitches in the row you are on while you are crocheting into the other rows.

**Round 17:** 8 SC, 3 SC to row three, SC [12].

**Rounds 18-22:** 5 rows SC [12 stitches per row].

**Round 23:** 9 SC, 3 SC to row 1 [12] stitches.

**Rounds 24-27:** 4 rows SC [12 stitches per row].

**Round 28:** SC to curl, 9 SC, 2 SC to curl [12 stitches].

**Round 29-38:** 10 rows SC [12 Stitches per row].

Lightly stuff bottom of tail and sew to back of body fanned out.
